

RENOVATIONS BEGIN

The redevelopment of the Portarlington Community Health Centre is underway. Builder Loaram Constructions is on site and has already completed demolition of the North wing of the building.

BCH services, including the Portarlington GP Clinic, pathology, podiatry and physiotherapy will continue to operate during the redevelopment.

There will be some impact from noise and truck movements around the site, but the builders will endeavor to keep that disruption to a minimum. BCH apologises for any inconvenience.

The redevelopment, which is funded through the Department of Health's Community Health and Hospitals Program, and the generous donation from the Portarlington Ladies Auxiliary is expected to be completed by the end of the year.

ART INSTALLATION

The works have been created as part of a BCH funded Arts Connection program which aimed to improve psychological wellbeing, social connectedness and positive management of chronic health conditions by engaging people with illness or disability in arts activities.
