

# Portarlington Redevelopment Update



## ARCHITECT APPOINTED

Bellarine Community Health (BCH) recently secured Federal Government funding for further redevelopment at the Portarlington Health Centre site in Fenwick Street.

The tender process for the Architects was recently completed and the selection panel awarded the contract to Four18, a Geelong based Architectural firm.

Four18 Architecture are now reviewing a scoping document for the project and organising for a site survey to determine land and building size.

Engagement with community groups via a survey, along with consultation with clients, staff, user groups and key stakeholders has helped inform the scope of the project.

BCH is keeping current user groups informed of the status and timelines for the project.

There will be an opportunity for further feedback on the preliminary designs in the coming weeks and an opportunity for engagement around the community use and programs delivered in the new multi-purpose space at the centre.
