Bellarine Community Health Dental Services can provide general and emergency dental care for both **public** and **private** patients.

A professional team of Dentists, Oral Health Therapists and Dental Assistants are committed to providing the best dental care using the latest techniques.

PUBLIC DENTAL CARE

Eligible patients of all ages are able to access treatment through the public dental program.

- · All children under 13 years of age
- Young people aged 13 17 years who hold or are dependants of a health care or pensioner concession card holder
- Adults aged 18 years and over who hold or are dependants of health care or pensioner concession card holders

CHILD DENTAL BENEFITS SCHEDULE (CDBS)

Children up to 17 years with no concession card may be entitled to receive up to \$1,000 of dental care every two years through *Medicare*.
